# Advent: A Time of Waiting – What are we Waiting for?

This Sunday is the first Sunday of Advent. This is the time of year when we spend waiting, preparing and reflecting on the birth of Christ anew in the world. This year we will have two opportunities to gather outside of Sunday morning to help lead and guide us through Advent. On Wednesday evenings at 6 pm, we will gather for a Holden Advent Service with the other two SpringHouse churches. The service is filled with singing and is a wonderful way to connect with the holy during Advent. It has been a joy to participate in this service with Salem and Lyndale during Advent and Lent. This service will last about thirty minutes so our handbell choir will be able to come to the service and make it to rehearsal on time. There will be a soup supper beginning at 5:30 pm. before the services.

We will also gather on Tuesday evenings at 7 pm for our Advent Study. This year's study is called "Advent, A Time of Waiting--What Are We Waiting For?" I am excited to lead this study and I hope you will mark your calendars for December 5, 12 and 19. We will be watching three sermons from our General Assembly in Indianapolis this past summer. We have begun a new chapter in the life of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), with the election of a new General Minister and President, Rev. Dr. Teresa Hord Owens. Along with a new chapter for the Disciples of Christ our world has changed in a variety of ways or at least due to technology we now know in an instant the changes that happen across the world. Advent is a time for us to slow down and reflect on the world and our role as followers of Jesus Christ.

The three sermons that we will watch will help us to better understand our place in the world as Disciples of Christ and imagine and reflect on where God is leading us as First Christian Church, Minneapolis. ## Film series offered on Advent Wednesdays

Lyndale UCC is inviting SpringHouse folks to join them on Wednesday evenings following the Holden Prayer Service for films from Lyndale's Racial Justice initiative. The films to be shown are as follows:

• Wednesday, December 6: "White Like Me." Anti-racist educator Tim Wise explores race and racism in the US through the lens of whiteness and white privilege.

• Wednesday, December 13: "The Doctrine of Discovery." Dakota filmmaker Sheldon Wolfchild's documentary tells the story of how little known Vatican documents led to laws and systems in the US and Canada that are still being used against Original Nations and Peoples.

• Wednesday, December 20: "13<sup>th</sup>." This 2016 documentary by Ava DuVernay explores the intersection of race, justice and mass incarceration in the United States.

## SpringHouse Board Notes

12 people attended the SpringHouse board meeting on Sunday, October 29. Highlights from the meeting include the following:

• Michael Vanderford reported on three SH Building Committee actions: 1) developing a list of approved vendors; 2) completing the tuckpointing work for \$10,948.79 which was under the \$12,000 budgeted for the project; 3) recommending that the 2018 budget include a capital maintenance fund with each congregation contributing annually \$333.

• Pastor Laurie presented a draft of a plan for the Personnel Committee to be responsible for the hiring/firing of child care and nursery staff. This plan has been approved by the Children's Ministry committee.

• The proposed 2018 budget was discussed at length with several suggestions for kitchen, marketing, joint ministry, and outreach. The 2018 SH budget proposal was approved as amended.

• Dates for 2018 SH meetings are January 7, April 29, September 30 and November 11.
